WCC Wedding FAQs

1. What is the average cost of a wedding held at WCC?

The average cost for a wedding held at WCC is \$850-\$1000. This includes all associated fees except for added technical needs. (Ex: personal programming)

2. Do I have to attend premarital counseling if I am not getting married at WCC?

Yes. Whether you are getting married onsite or offsite, all couples having a WCC Pastor officiate their wedding are required to complete premarital counseling. We take the responsibility of marrying couples very seriously; this means giving you the best start possible in your relationship of a lifetime.

3. What is the latest time of day I can have my wedding at the WCC Campus?

To allow our facilities team the time needed to clean and reset the auditorium for Sunday services, the latest time you may have your wedding is 3:30pm on a Saturday for a wedding only, and your wedding must be completed by 5:00pm. If you are having a reception, the latest time for your wedding is 1:30pm, and your wedding and reception must be completed by 7:00pm.

4. Can I have a Friday night wedding at WCC?

No. Due to ministry needs, we are only available for Saturday weddings.

5. Can I get married outdoors on the WCC Main Campus?

No. Weather plays a large factor in an outdoor wedding and due to the inconsistency of weather conditions and for the safety and pleasure of all, we do not allow outside weddings.

6. Can I choose the WCC Pastor of my choice?

Yes. However, the pastor you choose may not be available for your date. We have a list of pastors you can choose from if this happens.
